David KB3UBD called the meeting to order and asked the attendees to introduce themselves by name and call sign.

The minutes for the April meetings were submitted for publication in the May 2014 newsletter. A motion was made and carried to accept the minutes as published.

Joyce W5FJB reviewed the financial report for March and April 2014. A motion was made and carried to accept for audit the financial reports as published. She informed the membership that SafeHaven of Tarrant County received the donation made by the Club.
