Antenna mounts




Public Service

The regular meeting of the membership of the AARC was called to order at 7:35pm October 17th, 2014 by the President, Sherry W5YUP. Other board members present included the Vice President, David KB3UBD; Secretary, Andy KB2VQA; Treasurer, Joyce W5FJB; Emergency Coordinator, Bill AE5BT; Training Coordinator and Agent of Record, Phil N5PWW; Editor, Dennis N5ACK; and Repeater Trustee, Maurice KM5RF.

Sherry W5YUP called the meeting to order and asked the attendees to introduce themselves by name and call sign.

She informed the membership that the AARC will be celebrating its 60th anniversary in 2015. If you are interested in participating on the committee to organize the celebration, then contact Sherry.

Joyce W5FJB reviewed the treasurer's report from the month of August. A motion was made and carried to accept for audit the financial report as published. She reviewed the treasurer's report from the month of September and noted a correction to the total club treasury. The value should have read \$6,586.66. A motion was made and carried to accept for audit the financial report as corrected.

The minutes for the September meetings were submitted for publication in the October 2014 newsletter. A correction to the minutes was noted: The motion regarding the allocation of the sum of \$300 to replace the electric generator **had not** been made.

A motion was made and carried to accept the minutes as corrected.

Phil N5PWW continues to hold test sessions on the first and third Saturdays of the month. He will continue to accept ballots for the Ham of the Year at the next club meeting.

Dennis N5ACK published the October newsletter and distributed it.

Maurice KM5RF reported that he suspected the 147.14 repeater was causing intermittent interference on adjacent frequencies. The Board voted to turn off the repeater until an investigation can be conducted. The 70cm repeater will remain operational.



Rob May NV5E, having been appointed as the nominating committee chair, informed the membership that officer elections will be held at the November membership meeting. All offices are voted upon. The current President, Vice President, and Treasurer will not be seeking re-election for those offices. He is looking for a person to fill the office of Vice President.

A break was taken at 8:10pm.

Meeting resumed at 8:25pm with a show-and-tell on various ham radio equipment.

The meeting adjourned at 8:45pm. The sign-in sheet showed 27 people in attendance, 25 indicating AARC membership.
