The first half of this Class will be conducted 8AM - 4PM CT on Saturday February 3.

The second half of this Class will be conducted 8AM - 4PM CT on Saturday February 10.

Doug May's (WB5VQQ) Test Team will conduct the Technician License Exam 4PM - 5:30PM CT on February 10 at the end of the second half of this Class.

Pre-Exam Requirements:

An FCC Registration Number (FRN) is required to take the Exam - Go to this URL Address to apply for an FRN# -

A \$15 Cash Fee is required to take the Exam.

An additional \$35 Cash Fee is required from Participants that Pass the Exam to pay the FCC Technician License Fee.

Testing:


There is a \$14 cash fee for taking the test (if you pass and want to take the test for the next level, the \$14 covers the additional test(s) as well).

As of April 13, 2022 the FCC will begin charging an application fee of \$35.00 for license applications.

Also note you will need your FRN number and a valid email prior to taking that first test.

Meeting Minutes

November 2023 Membership Meeting Minutes submitted by Andy Kapushoc KB2VQA, Secretary

The regular meeting of the membership of the AARC was called to order on November 17th, 2023, at 7:31 pm by the President, Jack AA5VZ. Other board members present included Vice President, Torre AA5CX; Secretary, Andy KB2VQA; Treasurer and Repeater Trustee, Maurice KM5RF; Training Coordinator and Agent of Record, Phil N5PWW; Emergency Coordinator, Clayton K5CWS; and Editor, Trey AF5XS.

Jack AA5VZ called the meeting to order and asked attendees to introduce themselves by name and call sign.

Jack mentioned that the siren test held in November went well, and the next siren test will be held on December 6th. Jack thanked Joe Wigner K5MGY for his presentation of fox hunting and for volunteering to fill the position of nominating committee chair. Jack informed the membership that election of club officers will be held tonight. The election will be followed by an open discussion of various ham radio topics. The collection of "Ham of the Year" ballots will end tonight, with the presentation of the award taking place at the Christmas party on December 14th. Jack reminded the membership that money was allocated last month to participate in Winter Field Day. A discussion was had on various site locations. It was agreed upon to use the same site as last year, being J.W. Dunlop Sports Center.

Jack reminded the membership of the Irving ARC micro-grant program which provides money to assist in purchasing equipment to further the amateur radio hobby. During last month's meeting there was a discussion of obtaining a new repeater antenna. Jack has prepared the application for the micro-grant program and is ready to submit it.

Torre AA5CX mentioned that the election of officers will be held tonight. There is no official meeting in December, but there will be a Christmas party.

Philip KD5WBW, in the role of Public Information Officer, had nothing to report.

Andy KB2VQA noted that the November newsletter contained the minutes from the October meetings. A motion was made and carried to accept the minutes as published.

Maurice KM5RF reviewed the financial report. A motion was made and carried to accept the October report as published for audit.

Maurice reviewed with the membership his research on companies that can provide a new antenna for the repeater. Prices varied and he felt that the company providing the option that cost \$1,466 was the safest. An option provided last month costing \$1,000 was later determined to have some issues. Assuming that a micro-grant is awarded to cover half the cost of the safer option, a motion was made and carried to spend up to \$750 for the new repeater antenna.

Trey AF5XS compiled and distributed the newsletter for November 2023. The Christmas party will be held on Thursday, December 14th. The weekly net has been changed to Tuesday.

Phil N5PWW continues to hold testing sessions in person promptly at 10 am on the first and third Saturdays of the month at 401 W. Sanford Street (use the entrance on the north side). Fees include \$14 and a \$35 fee from the FCC which needs to be paid via their web site in a timely fashion. An FRN and active email address is required at the time of taking the exam.

Clayton K5CWS informed the membership of the upcoming volunteer opportunities for RACES members. There will be various runs and races, including the Jingle Bell Run and Candy Cane Course.

Old business: No old business was presented. New business: No old business was presented.

A break was taken at 8:30 pm. The meeting resumed at 8:47 pm with the nominating committee chair Joe K5MGY leading the election of club officers.

As nominating committee chair, Joe K5MGY assembled a slate of candidates which did not include president or vice president. All offices were open for nominations. Joe Wigner was nominated for president, and Price Woolridge was nominated for vice president.

The slate of candidates was as follows: President, Joe Wigner, K5MGY; Vice President, Price Wooldridge, K5NNL; Secretary, Andy Kapushoc KB2VQA; Treasurer, Maurice Martin KM5RF;

Training Coordinator, Phil Stage N5PWW; Emergency Coordinator, Clayton Starkweather K5CWS; and Editor, Trey Seastrunk AF5XS

It was asked three times if there were any additional nominations. No additional nominations were made. A motion was made that the slate of candidates be elected by acclamation. The motion carried, and a majority of those present voted in the affirmative. The slate of candidates was elected.

The meeting adjourned at 9:08 pm. The sign-in sheet showed 18 people in attendance, 17 indicating AARC membership. Zoom attendees numbered 3.

November 2023 Executive Board Meeting Minutes submitted by Andy Kapushoc KB2VQA, Secretary

The regular meeting of the Executive Board of the AARC was held on November 17th, 2023, at 6:41 pm. Present were President, Jack AA5VZ; Vice President, Torre AA5CX; Secretary, Andy KB2VQA; Treasurer and Repeater Trustee, Maurice KM5RF; Emergency Coordinator, Clayton K5CWS; Training Coordinator and Agent of Record, Phil N5PWW; and Editor, Trey AF5XS.

Jack AA5VZ called the meeting to order.

Jack mentioned that election of club officers will be held tonight. The next siren test will be held on December 6th. Jack will thank Joe Wigner K5MGY for his presentation of fox hunting and for volunteering for position of nominating committee chair. Jack will have the membership decide on a location to hold Winter Field Day activities in January.

Torre AA5CX mentioned that election of club officers will be held tonight and that the nominating committee chair has been able to fill all positions except for the offices of president and vice president.

Phil N5PWW continues to hold face to face testing sessions promptly at 10 am on the first and third Saturdays of the month. Training classes are not being held.

Philip KD5WBW, in the role of Public Information Officer, had nothing to report.

Andy KB2VQA confirmed that the November 2023 newsletter contained the minutes from the October 2023 meetings.

Maurice KM5RF reviewed the financial report. He provided historical financial information for the purpose of being informed while budgeting in the future. Maurice presented his research on companies that can provide a new antenna for the repeater. An application will be made to the Irving ARC micro-grant program to cover 50% of the cost of the antenna.

Trey AF5XS published and distributed the newsletter.

Clayton K5CWS had nothing to report.

The meeting adjourned at 7:31 pm.
