Beginning on Friday, September 6, 2024, Maxim Memorial Station W1AW will begin using a new 17-meter frequency for its scheduled CW transmissions due to increased activity near the current bulletin frequency. In order to reduce the possibility of interference, W1AW will move to 18077.5 kHz.





Meeting Minutes

July 2024 Membership Meeting Minutes submitted by Andy Kapushoc KB2VQA, Secretary

The regular meeting of the membership of the AARC was called to order on July 19th, 2024, at 7:00 pm by the President, Joe K5MGY. Other board members present included Vice President, Price K5NNL; Secretary, Andy KB2VQA; Treasurer and Repeater Trustee, Maurice KM5RF; Training Coordinator and Agent of Record, Phil N5PWW; Emergency Coordinator, Clayton K5CWS; and Editor, Trey AF5XS.

Joe K5MGY called the meeting to order and asked attendees to introduce themselves by name and call sign.

Joe informed the membership testing will be held tomorrow at the George W. Hawkes Downtown Library (2nd floor) promptly at 10 am.

The newsletter for July was published and distributed. A motion was made and carried to accept the meeting minutes from the June meetings as published. A motion was made and carried to accept the financial report for audit as published.

Old business: The new repeater antenna has arrived.

New business: Joe solicited feedback from the club on the topic of getting the currently non-functional 220 MHz repeater back on the air. Send your comments to Joe via email. Joe would also like suggestions on how to get the AARC name out there, and how to attract new members.

Phil informed the membership that there is no training being conducted due to not meeting the minimum participation of 10 people. Mansfield is currently offering training sessions. Testing sessions are held by Phil at the George W. Hawkes Downtown Library (2nd floor) promptly at 10 am on the first and third Saturdays of the month.

The business meeting adjourned at 7:14 pm.

The meeting concluded at 8:45 pm. The sign-in sheet showed 27 people in attendance, 26 indicating AARC membership. Zoom attendees numbered 0.

July 2024 Executive Board Meeting Minutes submitted by Andy Kapushoc KB2VQA, Secretary

The regular meeting of the Executive Board of the AARC was held on July 19th, 2024, at 6:00 pm. Present were President, Joe K5MGY; Vice President, Price K5NNL; Secretary, Andy KB2VQA; Treasurer and Repeater Trustee, Maurice KM5RF; Training Coordinator and Agent of Record, Phil N5PWW; Emergency Coordinator, Clayton K5CWS; and Editor, Trey AF5XS.

Joe K5MGY called the meeting to order. He informed the board that 2 club members contributed points to the AARC for aggregate club scoring during Field Day.

Price K5NNL informed the board that the evening's program will be the ice cream social and show-and-tell.

The August meeting will have a presentation by AMSAT on the topic of propagation. In September there might be a flea market.

Andy KB2VQA confirmed that the July 2024 newsletter contained the minutes from the June meetings.

Phil N5PWW informed the board that training classes are currently on hold. Testing sessions are held at the George W. Hawkes Downtown Library (2nd floor) promptly at 10 am on the first and third Saturdays of the month.

Clayton K5CWS will submit all the logs for Field Day by the July 23rd deadline.

Maurice KM5RF mentioned that the repeater is in working order and the new DB224 repeater antenna arrived. He submitted the financial report for publication.

A discussion was had on options for installing the new DB224 antenna. Joe suggested removing the 220 MHz antenna and using the mount for the new 2-meter antenna.

Phil noted that it would be better to keep the 220 MHz antenna as it currently is, so the club has the option of getting a 220 MHz repeater back on the air. Maurice informed the board that a new 220 MHz repeater costs approximately \$1800.

Joe mentioned that several questions precipitated from the discussion at last month's meeting. How to advertise the club? How to grow the club? He suggested that ways to get the AARC name out there may be to rent a table at a hamfest and staff it with club members, and activities such as kit building.

The meeting adjourned at 6:53 pm.
