Meeting Minutes

August 2024 Membership Meeting Minutes submitted by Andy Kapushoc KB2VQA, Secretary

The regular meeting of the membership of the AARC was called to order on August 16th, 2024, at 7:00 pm by the President, Joe K5MGY. Other board members present included Vice President, Price K5NNL; Secretary, Andy KB2VQA; Treasurer and Repeater Trustee, Maurice KM5RF; Training Coordinator and Agent of Record, Phil N5PWW; Emergency Coordinator, Clayton K5CWS; and Editor, Trey AF5XS.

Joe K5MGY called the meeting to order and asked attendees to introduce themselves by name and call sign.

Joe informed the membership that a test session would be held tomorrow and that the test team is present from 9 am to 10 am. A quarterly drill with be held on August 30th for medical facilities that have amateur radio equipment. On September 4th there will be a siren test, and on September 7 there will be a test session.

The newsletter for August was published and distributed.

A motion was made and carried to accept the meeting minutes from the July meetings as published.

A motion was made and carried to accept the financial report for audit as published.

Old business: There was no old business.

New business: Joe proposed that the club have a fall picnic on the Saturday after the club meeting in October. The membership expressed interest in doing so.

Maurice asked the membership to verify that they have their APRS transmit settings configured correctly. He observed that someone was transmitting their APRS information through the repeater for 5 hours.

Price K5NNL mentioned that at the October meeting there will be a flea market. The membership should consider what they would want to sell.

Clayton K5CWS noted that RACES is looking for hams to assist with communications for the Plano Balloon Festival (September 19th - 22nd).

The business meeting adjourned at 7:09 pm.

At 7:22 pm Tom Schuessler N5HYP started his presentation via Zoom on the topic of HF propagation.

The meeting concluded at 8:36 pm. The sign-in sheet showed 19 people in attendance, 18 indicating AARC membership. Zoom attendees numbered 3.

August 2024 Executive Board Meeting Minutes submitted by Andy Kapushoc KB2VQA, Secretary

The regular meeting of the Executive Board of the AARC was held on August 16th, 2024, at 6:01 pm. Present were President, Joe K5MGY; Vice President, Price K5NNL; Secretary, Andy KB2VQA; Treasurer and Repeater Trustee, Maurice KM5RF; Training Coordinator and Agent of Record, Phil N5PWW; Emergency Coordinator, Clayton K5CWS; and Editor, Trey AF5XS.

Joe K5MGY called the meeting to order.

Price K5NNL informed the board that the evening's program will be provided via Zoom by Tom Schuessler N5HYP on the topic of HF propagation. In September Jack Weaver AA5VZ will present on the topic of building an antenna for listening to weather satellites. In October there will be a flea market, and in November there will be the election of club officers along with a presentation that has yet to be determined. There is a plan to make a trip to the National Weather Service in October to view a balloon launch

Andy KB2VQA confirmed that the August 2024 newsletter contained the minutes from the July meetings. It is being considered to change the monthly dining out on the Saturday after the club meeting to be include each Saturday and be at the same restaurant each time.

Trey AF5XS published the newsletter and updated the information regarding the new time and place for testing sessions.

Phil N5PWW informed the board that training classes are currently on hold. Testing sessions are held at the George W. Hawkes Downtown Library (2nd floor) on the first and third Saturdays of the month. The test team arrives at approximately 9 AM with the official start of testing at 10 AM.

Clayton K5CWS started a conversation concerning Field Day 2026 and whether the club would participate solo or combine with another club. Joe suggested that it will depend on how many club members would be participating. Joe is assembling 4 stations for use during Field Day.

Maurice KM5RF reported that the repeater is in working order. He submitted the financial report for publication. Maurice mentioned the new DB224 antenna is planned to be installed in October.

Joe suggested that a 3rd micro grant proposal might be for a 220 MHz repeater. Joe asked Clayton to continue seeking a meeting room from a church that would also possibly include a storage facility to allow the club to move out of the current storage facility that the club is using. Joe asked the board to consider having a club picnic on the Saturday after the October club meeting.

Philip KD5WBW asked the board to consider setting up a Get On The Air (GOTA) station at the Grand Prairie Farmers Market on September 7. The cost of a table is \$100.

David Walker W5DJO reported to the board that amateur radio stations are active in 4 medical

facilities in Arlington. On Friday August 30th a drill will be conducted. The drill is conducted quarterly.

The meeting adjourned at 6:45 pm.
